St John's Lunchtime & After School Clubs – Terms 5 & 6

At St John's we recognise the importance of interest and hobbies outside of the classroom and we encourage all students to take part in clubs for at least two hours a week. This funding is automatically available to students who are entitled to Free School Meals. Please provide a copy of your current tax year Tax Credit Notice Form (TC602) if this is the case.

***Rock Club** - A popular after-school club each Wednesday, in the music corridor between 15:15 – 16:30 (£35.00/half term). A great opportunity to play in a group/band situation in a positive, supportive musical environment, with assistance and guidance from a professional musician. The club offers dedicated rehearsal space and some allocated equipment/backline each week. The course leader helps each band with lyric writing, playing covers or developing own compositions. Subject to numbers/demand, there may be an opportunity to perform and showcase at the end of the term (not compulsory). Band recordings/videos may also be available at extra cost. Existing bands as a whole are encouraged, as well as individuals who can also join up and be placed in a band. Please do not simply turn up to play without telling us first! We need to allocate the students into the bands to ensure a balance of instruments/abilities. All abilities and contemporary instruments welcome, singers in particular are always in short supply! No band experience necessary.
