St John's Lunchtime & After School Clubs – Terms 3 & 4

At St John's we recognise the importance of interest and hobbies outside of the classroom and we encourage all students to take part in clubs for at least two hours a week. To this end a wide range of activities such as sport, arts, music, hobbies, volunteering, mentoring, homework clubs, and booster sessions are on offer. Research has proven that young people who do take part in extracurricular activities have increased confidence, higher self-esteem, and greater social skills – attributes we are keen to nurture to ensure our students succeed in life.

St John's Opportunity Fund provides money to subsidise the cost of clubs to help ensure that young people do not miss out because of financial constraints at home. This funding is automatically available to students who are entitled to Free School Meals. If your family income is less than £25,000pa a 50% discount of the cost of any of the activities is available. Swindon Town Football Skills Coaching

Boys & Girls Y7-Y9 – Football skills coaching will take place every Wednesday, from 15.10–16.20 on the Lower Field starting on 9 January 2019 and ending on 3 April 2019 (not including 20 February) at a cost of £54.00.

The Swindon Town, FA qualified football coaching will consist of 12 structured sessions to include warm ups, skills based practice, competitive and non-competitive competitions, and a short game to show what they have learnt which helps bring all the skills together.
