Dear Parents

St John's utilises an online tool which will help keep track of your son or daughter's homework. Show My Homework enables you to see details of the tasks that your child has been set, review submissions and analyse feedback. The service also provides other benefits which have been outlined below:

- 24/7 online access via a personal account
- Download resources associated with homework tasks
- Establish when homework has been set and when it is due
- Evaluate how long students should be working on assignments
- Ability to translate homework tasks into other languages
- Download free apps for iOS and Android devices
- Receive automated notifications or alerts (optional)

Your son or daughter has been issued with a login slip which explains how to create parent/guardian accounts. Simply visit http://showmyhomework.co.uk/pin and follow the instructions to review their homework calendar. If you already have an existing account please go to the 'Edit Profile' section and enter the 'Parental Code' to link them accordingly.

Students are being formally introduced to the new platform and teachers will continue using the service to set all homework tasks. Planners can still be used to help students manage their time and will continue to provide an important communication link.

We hope this service will empower parents, enabling you to gain a deeper understanding of homework that has been set. The service should also help students to improve organisation and manage their time effectively.

Please ask your son or daughter to speak with their tutor if they have not received a login slip.
