Sixth Form Progress Review – Year 12

There will be a meeting for parents of all Year 12 students on **Wednesday 23 January 2019**. This will be an important opportunity for discussion about your son's or daughter's progress since joining the Sixth Form.

Subject staff will be available for individual discussion from 4.00 pm to 7.00 pm. For this meeting we are using an appointment system to save 'waiting time'. Please ask your son/daughter to arrange appointments at times suitable for you.

Information about the university application procedure will be available in the Atrium and there is a useful section for the parents of students interested in applying to university on the UCAS website, www.ucas.com. We are also hosting a Moving On Fair for students on Wednesday 30 January 2019. Students are looking at a range of post-18 options during Social Studies this year, including information from our Careers Advisor on planning futures, careers, apprenticeships and work experience. Our Careers Advisor, Mrs Havill, will be available in the Atrium for any queries regarding the work experience programme w/b 8 July and the National Citizenship Service are also attending as part of their activity programme available for students. NCS will be giving a presentation to Year 12 students on 28 February in Social Studies.

If you are driving to parents' evening, we would very much appreciate it if you could avoid arriving on site prior to 3.45 pm as this will clash with bus departure times.

We hope that you will be able to come given the importance of this year's work. Year 12 end of year exams will be held from Friday 21 – Wednesday 26 June 2019. All students will be given timetables well in advance so they should know when their exams are. Year 12 reports will be sent home to parents w/b 6 May 2019. Please note that Year 12 students will continue at school until the end of term on Friday 19 July 2019.

Can I also remind you that we do expect students to attend tutorial every day and encourage them to be in school from 8.30 am – 3.10 pm each day to make use of our excellent study facilities when not in lessons. This was outlined in our September information to parents sent at the beginning of the year.
